

## 13+ Admissions at the City of London School

**We are changing the way we admit boys to the School at 13 for entry September 2014 onwards.**

### **Boys currently in Year 6 and below**

(i.e. if your son was born in the school year September 2000 – August 2001 or later).

We will be examining candidates when they are in Year 6. The written entrance examinations will be in maths and English and there will be a computerised reasoning test. These examinations will take place in January.

A boy who is currently in Year 6 will be examined on Thursday, 19<sup>th</sup> January 2012 for entry in September 2014.

If a candidate does well at his entrance examinations, he will be called for interview in February and a place offered towards the end of that month. An acceptance will be required in early March 2012 and a non-refundable acceptance fee of £1000 paid to hold the place.

A non refundable deposit (a term's fees minus £1000) will need to be paid the following year, in autumn 2013.

The place will be confirmed by the result of the candidate's Common Entrance examinations in summer 2014. In the unlikely event of a candidate failing Common Entrance, the place would be withdrawn and the deposit would be refunded in full.

**PARENTS OF BOYS WHO ARE CURRENTLY IN YEAR 6 AND WHO ARE APPLYING FOR ENTRY AT 13+ TO THE SCHOOL IN 2014 WILL NEED TO REGISTER BY THE END OF NOVEMBER 2011.**

### **Boys currently in Year 7 and above**

If your son is currently in Year 7, or above, our 'old' system will apply. He will be examined in the January of his Year 8 for entry the following September. He will be examined in maths, English, science and French, with interviews in February and acceptances required, with a deposit, in March for entry in the September. The deadline for registrations is the end of the November prior to the January examinations.
