

Junior Sixth French Easter Revision

1. **Oral exam:** Make sure that you have fully prepared your answers to all the questions likely to come up. See the lists of set questions issued by ATL and the information sheet on the website about the format of the exam to make sure that you know exactly what to expect at each stage. Use the Kerboodle website (see below for details).
2. **Vocabulary:** absolutely vital, so revise and consolidate the vocabulary and key phrases from the AQA AS French text book, as well as from your own notes, supplementing this with the material on the Kerboodle website (see below for details).

4. **General reading:** anything at all (newspapers, magazines, internet, e.g. www.lexpress.fr)
5. **Kerboodle:** This is the online material attached to your coursebook. Go to <http://www.kerboodle.com/>. You will be asked for a username, password and organisation code. The organisation code is 8906.

We would particularly recommend the Support and Assessment section, where you will find the Vocabulary Builder section and, in separate folders, sections entitled On Your Marks and Examiner's Tips. We would prefer you not to attempt the Examination-style questions as we shall use them in class, although you may like to look at the ones for the oral exam.
