

Senior Sixth Spanish Easter Revision

1. **Oral exam:** Make sure that you are fully au fait with all the non-cultural topics, focusing on topic-specific vocabulary and language of argument. Use your AQA A2 text book to help you prepare arguments for and against the different topics on the stimulus cards, examples of which you have been given. Prepare answers to the lists of questions you have been given on **La obra de un dramaturgo** ('La casa de Bernarda Alba') and **La obra de un autor hispanohablante** ('Nada' or 'La tregua')
2. **Vocabulary:** absolutely vital so revise as much as possible, mainly from your own notes, but supplemented also by lists you have been given from AQA A2 text book and *Ponte al Día*.
3. **Reading comprehension:** some practice tests (with answers) from Authentik were given out at the end of term.
4. **Grammar:** revise anything we have covered over the two years from your own notes and any handouts, supplemented by the worksheets given out at the end of term (with answers) from *Ponte al Día*.
5. **Listening:** try to keep this going via some websites such as <http://www.rtve.es/rne/envivo.htm>;
