Law and the LNAT If you are planning to study law at any of the following Universities; Birmingham, Bristol, Durham, Glasgow, King's College London, Leeds, Nottingham, Oxford, UCL then you will need to take the National Admissions Test for Law (LNAT). In order to do this you need to register on line and book a test date and centre at which to take the test. The web site address is <http://www.lnat.ac.uk/2009/> which has all the relevant information about registering, what the test is, where you take it, where and so forth. You need to go here and study it carefully. Please also bear in mind deadlines which include October 15th for Oxford for registering and sitting the test by November 1st. Oxbridge If for any reason you are applying to Oxbridge and have been delayed getting your form submitted, you must at the very minimum have informed Mr Bracken (AJB) or Mr Ellis-Rees (WER) of your choice of college and course by Thursday October 1st at the very latest. Failure to do so may well restrict your ability to submit an application.

Oxford A reminder than any 6th former who is applying to Oxford to study any of the following English, PPE, Economics & Management, Experimental Psychology or PPP needs to see Mr Bracken as soon as possible as you need to register online to sit the English Language Assessment Test or Thinking Skills Assessment Test.

UCAS

Please ensure you follow the correct procedures – it will speed the process.

1. Complete draft form and give your tutor a copy to check. **DO NOT CLICK SUBMIT.**
2. Amend your form in the light of discussions with tutor. When your tutor is satisfied with your form they will **SIGN IT.**
3. Bring **SIGNED** form to Careers Centre and give to Careers Secretary. (She will not accept unsigned forms.)
4. AJB will check your form and send it back to you via your tutor with instruction to either: **AMEND** or **SUBMIT.**
5. If you have to Amend then make changes and return to AJB **along with the original with AJB's comments**– (no need to resubmit to tutor). AJB will then check and return form to you to **SUBMIT.**
6. Please adhere to the deadlines. **MON 12th OCT for (non Oxbridge/Medics/Dentists).**
