2. Amend your form in the light of discussions with tutor. When your
tutor is satisfied with your form they will **SIGN IT.**
3. Bring **SIGNED** form to Careers Centre and give to Careers
Secretary. (She will not accept unsigned forms.)
4. AJB will check your form and send it back to you via your tutor with
instruction to either: **AMEND** or **SUBMIT.**
5. If you have to Amend then make changes and return to AJB **along**
with the original with AJB's comments– (no need to resubmit to
tutor). AJB will then check and return form to you to **SUBMIT.**
