- September–October** Law National Admissions Test (LNAT) to be taken at an approved test centre by candidates for Law. Please see www.lnat.ac.uk for further details. This must be taken before 1 November.
- 21-3 September** Tests for Organ Scholarships take place at Oxford.
- 24 and 25 September** Tests for Choral Scholarships take place at Oxford.
- 15 October 2009** Last date for completion of UCAS applications for candidates applying to Oxford.
