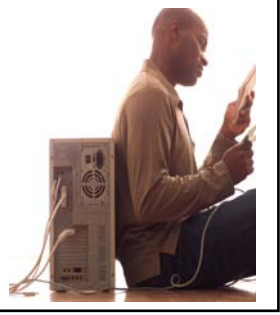

1. Complete draft form and give your tutor a copy to check. **DO NOT CLICK SUBMIT.**
2. Amend your form in the light of discussions with tutor. When your tutor is satisfied with your form they will **SIGN IT.**
3. Bring **SIGNED** form to Careers Centre and give to Careers Secretary. (She will not accept unsigned forms.)
4. CP will check your form and send it back to you via your tutor with instruction to either: **AMEND** or **SUBMIT.**
5. If you have to Amend then make changes and return to CP **along with the original with CP's comments**– (no need to resubmit to tutor). CP will then check and return form to you to **SUBMIT.**
6. Please adhere to the deadlines.
