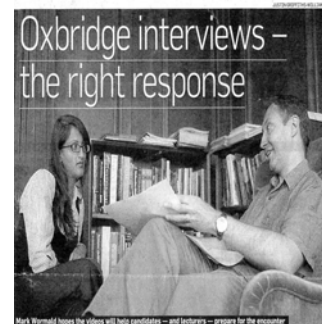

The Weizmann Institute, Israel, holds an international science program for talented students during the summer in between sixth form and university. A select number of students work with graduate and PhD students in their current research in one of the five areas; Biology, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Physics, and Mathematical Sciences. The first three weeks of the four-week program are spent in the state-of-the-art laboratories at the world renown research institute and culminate in a written paper and oral presentation, while the fourth week of the program is spent doing fieldwork in the Judean Desert.
