

3rd Form French
End of Year Exam

The exam will cover everything that has been covered this year and so you should focus your revision on units 1-3 of Tricolore Total 4.

Marks will be allocated as follows:

- Listening 20%
- Grammar 25%
- Reading 25%
- Writing 30%

The listening will take place during a French lesson the week before half Term, and the Grammar, Reading and Writing will make up the written paper during exam week.

Listening and Reading

The listening and reading sections will be a range of activities and will relate to the topics from chapters 1-3 as well as your general knowledge of French. Revise the vocabulary from the end of each unit.

Grammar

This will consist of a range of exercises. The following topics should be learnt thoroughly. This will be strictly marked with 100% accuracy expected. There will be no half marks for missed accents etc.

- The Present Tense – Regular and Irregular verbs
- The Perfect Tense – ‘Etre’ and ‘Avoir’ verbs
- The Future Tense
- Depuis constructions
- Negatives – (including *pas, rien, personne, que, ni...ni, jamais* etc)

Writing

This will consist of 2 tasks, a shorter task (60-80 words), worth 10 marks and a longer, more complex task (100-150 words), worth 20 marks. For the longer task you will be expected to use a range of tenses, vocabulary and sentence structure.

Topics will be taken from the following:

- Favourite / Worst days of the week
- Family life
- Local area
- Town and country
- Transport and journeys
