

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Form German – Summer Exam Revision

- Your listening exam will be before half term. After half term you will have a grammar and writing exam. This sheet summarises the areas on which you will be tested.

#### **Grammar:**

- **Present tense regular verbs** (p118 Echo Express 1)
- **Present tense irregular verbs** *essen, fahren, lesen, nehmen, schlafen, sehen* (p119 Echo Express 1)
- **Present tense *haben* and *sein*** (p120 Echo Express 1)
- **Perfect tense** verbs with *sein* and *haben* auxiliaries (P121 – 123 Echo Express 2) including the full list of past participles on p123
- **Word order**, remembering in particular that the conjugated verb comes 2<sup>nd</sup>, and past participles/ infinitives come at the end. After the verb remember TIME-MANNER-PLACE.
- **When and how to use the nominative, accusative and dative cases** for THE / A / MY:
  - *Nominative*
    - *the subject of a sentence (doing the action):* “The boy gives flowers to his mother”
  - *Accusative*
    - *the direct object of a sentence (having the action directly done to it).* “The boy gives flowers to his mother”.
    - Also used after prepositions such as IN when describing movement.
  - *Dative*
    - *the indirect object of a sentence (having the action indirectly done to it):* “The boy gives flowers to his mother”
    - *ALWAYS used after ZU / MIT*
    - *Used after in / auf / hinter / über / unter / zwischen / vor when describing the location of an object or an action*

*EIN (a) / KEIN (no) / DEIN (your) / SEIN (his) / IHR (her) follow the same pattern as MEIN.*
